Print + Draw + Fold Exploring mixed media within a Leporello format with Sandra Pearce

Workshop outline -

Day one will start with monoprinting using a gelatine plate exploring advanced printing techniques including composition, registration, transparent layers, white over dark, and self-made stencils.

We will explore the idea of the Leporello – an accordion fold book format - both basic and more creative including popups, cutouts and stitching.

During day two you'll work in your chosen book format, combining monoprinting with drawing, tracing, collage and mark making to create a unique narrative that expresses your personal and creative style.

At the end of the weekend, you'll have a stack of colourful prints, decorated papers to cut up and work with, and at least one artist book.

- 300gsm rough or semi-rough watercolour paper one large sheet approx.A2 size per student
- 185gsm+ watercolour paper one large sheet approx. A2 size per student
- Good quality acrylic paints in your favourite colours
- Waterproof black markers 0.8, 0.5, 0.2
- Watercolour kit including paints, brushes, water containers (water soluble pencils, inktense pencils, watercolour/gouache tubes or pans – whatever you have)
- Your usual drawing materials pencils, eraser, sharpener
- Objects to draw and inspire seed pods, leaves, sticks, stones, flowers, buds, insects, feathers, etc
- Inspiring imagery (ok to be on digital device if preferred)
- Objects to print with string, netting, lace, leaves etc
- A4 Cartridge paper or scrap drawing paper
- Bone folder / paper scorer (if you have one)
- Cutting mat, scalpel, Stanley knife, metal ruler
- HB Pencil & eraser
- Large metal spoon (the heavier the better)
- Small water spray bottle
- Gelli plate and rubber roller (if you have them, otherwise this will be supplied by tutor)

- Gelatine plates
- Rollers
- Bone folders / scorers for those who don't have one
- Examples and samples
